Max. poster measurements: VERTICAL PRESENTATION

Width: 90cm Height: 150cm

- We suggest you design your poster layout as follows:
 - Title, author, address (on the upper edge, across the width of the whole poster)
 - o Introduction and Purpose
 - Methods
 - o Results
 - Conclusions
 - Disclosure

- 90 cm
- **Disclosure** of conflict of interest (e.g. grant support, consultancy, membership on advisory councils, speaker's bureau) and source of funding **is mandatory**. Please prepare **for each listed author** a one sentence statement to this effect.
- The title should be emphasised by the use of a bold type face. This writing should be easily readable at a distance of 2 3 meters. The text can be broken up by the inclusion of drawings, charts and photos.
- To promote your work you may like to bring handouts for distribution to interested delegates.
- Poster numbers will be provided and fixed at each poster wall. Your poster number can be found from mid-July 2019 on the congress website <u>www.ectrims-congress.eu</u> under "Scientific programme".
 Material to affix the posters will be provided.
- Please <u>strictly</u> adhere to the mounting and removal times. If the poster has not been removed by the end of the allocated removal time, it will be disposed of by congress staff.
- An electronic version of your poster is also requested. Separate instructuions are available and have been sent to instructions will be sent to you in a separate email in August. Your electronic poster will then be available for continuous viewing throughout the entire congress onsite on special ePoster temrinals. It will also be available for viewing in the ECTRIMS Online Library after the congress.
